





## **Notes**

Dennis Specialist Vehicles Ltd. Squash Championships

This years championships will be divided into 6 sections.

- United Kingdom Fire Services Individual Championship in which entry is limited to 4 players per District.
- Veterans Championship open to members of the Fire Service over the age of 40 on the 1st May 1989
- Ladies Championship open to all female members of the Fire Service.
- 4) Plate competition for players who lose their first match in the preliminary or first rounds of event 1.
- 5) Team competition for which points are awarded in event 1.
- 6) Veterans plate competition for first game losers in event 2.

No player may enter more than one championship.

All matches other than the finals are scheduled to be played on the Saturday. In extreme circumstances and at the request of both semi-finalists this match may be played on the Sunday.




Thanks also to the St. Melyd Squash Club for putting up with us for the last 13 years and their members who allow us to occupy their club for the weekend.



On Friday we were to meet the Police and expected a hard match. Results as follows.



After a well deserved rest and some food the tournament commenced and the result was as follows.



The result was the icing on the cake which also gave us second place in the tournament. Both Steve and John had very hard games, both going to 5 sets.


Don continued his good form by winning two matches in one day without dropping a set, and Bob managed the same.




We had a cracking breakfast and set out for Londonderry where we spent the morning looking around the town and shopping. We also visited the border area where you can look down on Bogside.

In the afternoon we visited Giants Causeway which was quite impressive and sat on the beach preparing overselves for our first match that evening against a Colrane Club side.





My thanks once again to all our colleagues in Northern Ireland and to the players who represented the Fire Service on this tour for their support.


