Narrative report for 2021 AGM

'We were able to play some cricket last summer, albeit under quite strict restrictions. Thankfully we managed to receive some sponsorship money and we weren't too adversely affected financially by COVID restrictions. We saved money by not providing the kit we were planning and reducing the accommodation costs due to the issues with sharing. 2021 sees a full fixture list and the expectation that those previous costs will be back to normal including accommodation, ground hire and catering. We have managed to get some high profile fixtures this year against the MCC and the Lords Taverners which may bring incurred costs higher than normal.

2021 sees some progression of a women's national team, they have had their first training session and we hope to purchase kit and have a fixture before the end of the summer, hence the slight increase in our request for grant funding this year. An AGM did take place over Teams with good turn out and discussions about the plans for the year, our Chair DCFO Apter retires at the end of June with a new chair due to take over from him sometime throughout the summer.'
