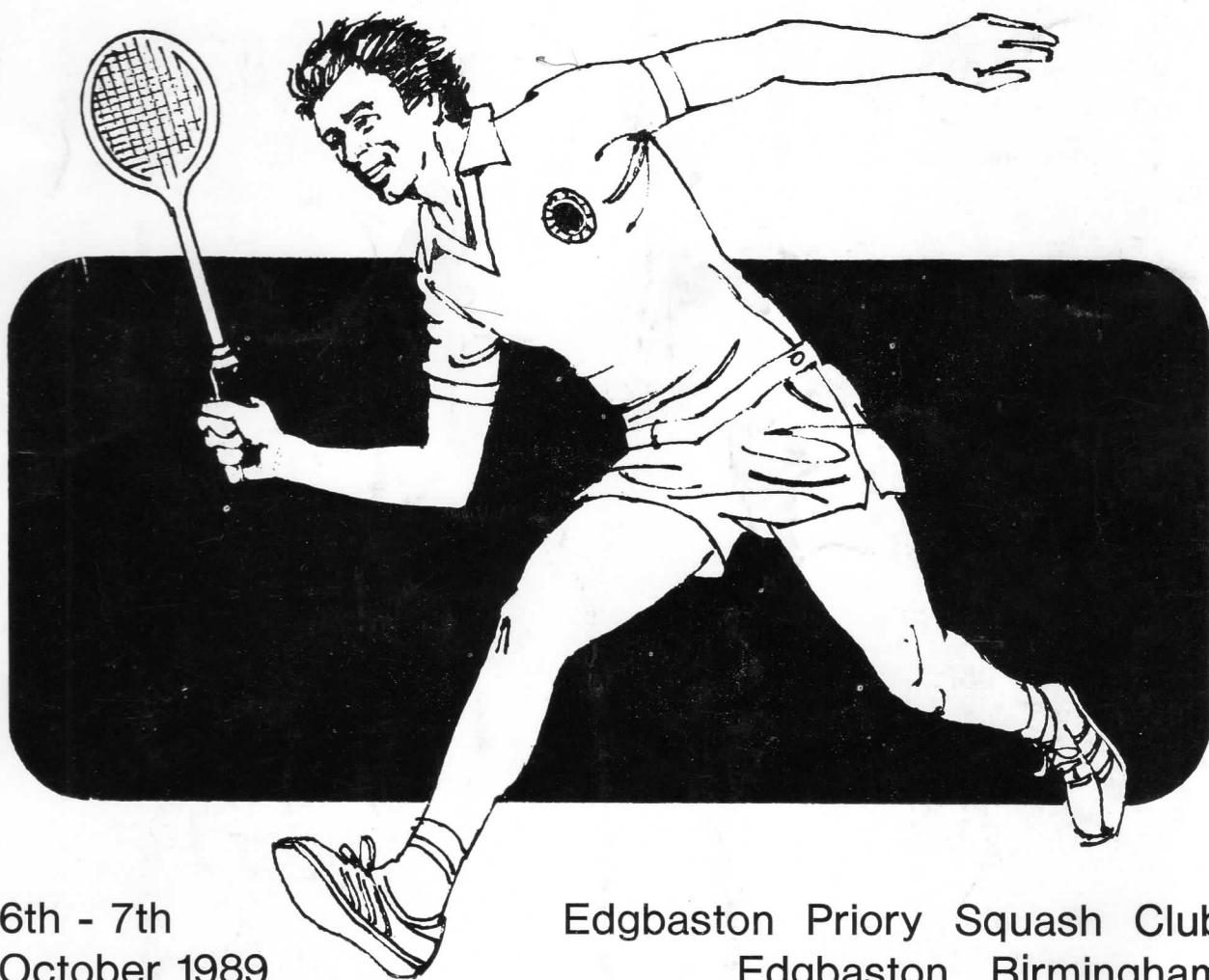

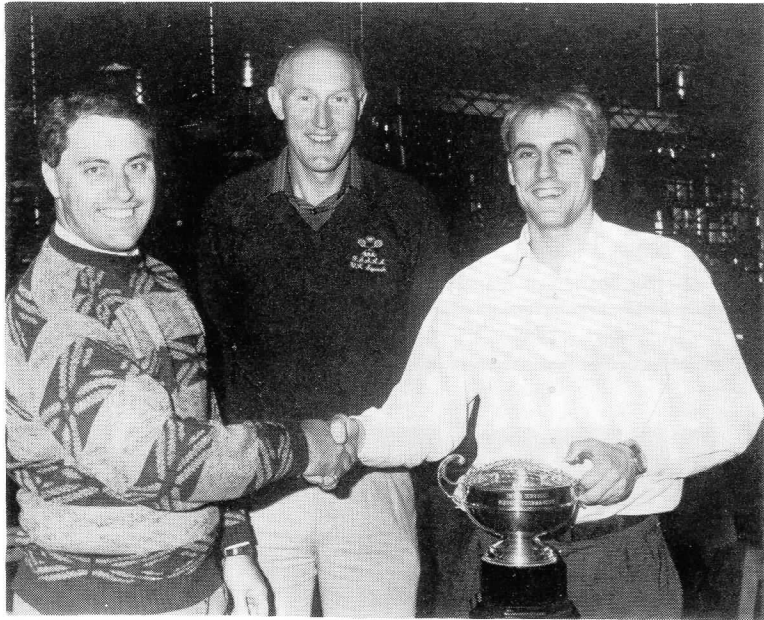
Strings 5—4—1—3—6
